Sparkling

S1 Prosecco Brut, Amori £19.95
This example has all we look for in a Prosecco, with its gentle pear, white peach and apple flavours and subtle effervescence

S2 Pinot Grigio Rose Brut, Mirabello £19.95
Full of vibrant raspberry and red berry flavours, delicate fizz and a finish which is just right for celebrations

White Wines

Delicate, fresh whites

W1 2016 Pinot Grigio Amori, Italy £17.00
Appealing floral aroma and ripe stone fruit flavour on the palate. The perfect aperitif, but try with light salads and pasta dishes too.

W5 2016 Rioja Blanco, Bodegas Urbina, Spain £25.00
New style white Rioja with no oak made by the talented Benito Urbina. The inviting nose of melon, apple, and pear is irresistible and leads you to a palate which is smooth-textured, flavourful and lively.

Herbaceous and aromatic whites

W2 2017 Sauvignon Blanc, Ladera Verde, Central Valley £16.50
Fruity and crisp Sauvignon Blanc from a top Chilean estate. Full of ripe fruit with a refreshing citrus character to the finish.

W6 2017 Viognier "Elisabeth", Domaine de La Baume, Pays d'Oc, France £24.00
All that is best about Viognier here, with aromatic floral notes, honeyed peach and pear fruit and an exotic, opulent character. Takes rich sauces in its stride.

W3 2017 Sauvignon Blanc, Nika Tiki, Marlborough, NZ £23.50
All the popular Marlborough freshness, with complex herbaceous notes and pure, verdant fruit flavours.

W7 2016 Sancerre, François Millet £30.00
Classically Sancerre on the palate, with the crisp, fresh acidity of classic Sauvignon. François Millet is a small grower in Bué, the best village in the "appellation"

W8 2017 Chenin Blanc, Wide River, Robertson, South Africa £
Chenin Blanc at its very best. light and fresh, yet with a good depth of soft white fruit, apple and a slight honeyed character. One of the best value whites on our list

Full flavoured, rich whites

W4 2016 Freedom Cross Chardonnay, Fransschhoek, South Africa £18.00
Full-bodied, balanced and elegant. A rich butter Chardonnay with a touch of tropical fruit among big citrus flavours.

ROSE1	2015 Pinot Grigio Blush, Amori, Italy <i>Fresh, dry and crammed with summer fruit flavours. The perfect wine for any sunny day sat outside or quite simply on its own.</i>	£17.00
ROSE2	Foxcover White Zinfandel, California <i>Coral pink in colour. Delicate and refreshing with soft fruit flavours of strawberries and peaches</i>	£18.00
ROSE3	2016 Rosé des Lices, Pays de Var, Provence, France <i>A very pretty Provençal rosé, pale in colour with pronounced notes of strawberries and exotic fruit. Crisp and fresh with a great balance of perfume and ripe red fruit.</i>	£22.50

Light and Delicate Reds

RED2	2016 Rioja Joven Tinto, Viña Marro, Spain <i>"Joven" means young- supple, juicy Rioja from a very good small bodega. Great with red meats, but the tannins are light and barely noticeable making this a strong contender to drink on its own.</i>	£22.00
RED5	2015 Fleurie "Présidente Marguerite", Beaujolais, France <i>Silky tannins and very ripe black fruit. The powerful structure that still bears the stamp of youth comes through at the end with spicy, peppery notes</i>	£27.50

Spicy, Peppery, Warming Reds

RED3	2015 Merlot, Pato Torrente, Central Valley, Chile <i>An intense violet colour with aromas of blackberry and plum leaping from the glass. Named after Chile's "Torrent Duck"</i>	£16.95
RED1	2017 Malbec, Las Pampas, Mendoza, Argentina <i>The bright purplish red colour and aromas of fresh berries, dark cherry and coffee are an immediate attraction. The depth of fruit on the palate, backed up by soft ripe tannins, will only further your enjoyment.</i>	£18.50
RED4	Wide River, Shiraz <i>This is a wonderful example of the Syrah grape, showing the best qualities of the variety. It has a strong, complex aroma of dark cherry and violets with a hint of smoke and white pepper</i>	£18.50
RED6	2017 Barbera d'Alba, Enzo Boglietti, Piemonte <i>There is a structured, earthy core to this Barbera whilst a veil of freshness and fine tannin complete this modern, bold and expressive wine.</i>	£35.00
RED7	2016 Malbec Reserva, Gouguenheim, Mendoza, Argentina <i>Deep purple colour with aromas of red fruits, chocolate and coffee beans, bursting with red and black cherry flavours and a delicate floral aroma. Warming and powerful with extended ageing in American oak.</i>	£27.50
RED8	2016 Rioja Semi-Crianza, Monte Araya <i>A fantastic fruit-packed Rioja, the semi Crianza style spends just 3 months in oak barrels prior to bottling. Full of cherry flavours and a fantastic finish.</i>	£25.00
RED9	2016 Merlot, Domaine de La Baume, Pays d'Oc <i>Lots of warmth and ripe fruit in this southern-french merlot. La Baume is a favourite producer of ours, and there is structure, suppleness and plenty of plum and damson fruit.</i>	£24.50
